This course covers all the fundamentals of Agile learning objectives set forth by the International Consortium for Agile (ICAgile) and qualifies its attendees to become certified ICAgile Associates once they complete the course and the associated exam. The course goes into greater depth about all the roles and responsibilities on the team not just the "ScrumMaster." EXAM AND CERTIFICATION
